Monthly report given by Chief Kronenberger:

- Starting to see increase in call volume up 7% from same time period as last year, up 1.5% year to date & false alarms are climbing
 - 43 false alarms at the college last month & 60 the month prior going to take a look at
 - o Fire Marshals on campus 12 man hours and the Alarms Division had 14 man hours on campus for the month
- Moved ahead with a lot of technology upgrades over the last month:
 - All the fire apparatus now have Ipads took the old MDT's off – keeping records management system on it as well dispatching software, everything being done electronically
 - o Installed TV monitors/computers in both stations in their day room and apparatus floor so all the dispatch software is up there, now get notified a lot quicker of a call
- Training very busy for month of October:
 - Refreshed all of SCBA, rapid intervention training, and ICS training, conducted live fire training for all shifts in New Haven, and did trench rescue class for all response personnel
 - October is Fire Prevention Month conducted 24 educational programs for different schools & organizations
- Currently both the Fire Department & Emergency Management are gearing up for the tree lighting & fireworks evening

 Finished fine tuning the last specs – still on track to be here around July 1st
