

LEGAL NOTICE

Notice of decision of the Inland Wetlands and Watercourses Agency of the City of Middletown, Connecticut, at its regular meeting held on Wednesday, May 7, 2008.

1. Approved an application to remove obstructions (fallen trees and limbs) from the Coginchaug River between Veteran's Park and the North End Peninsula. Applicant/Agent The Jonah Center for Earth and Art. (08-04)
2. Approved a request for a three year extension for permit #03-12 for construction activities associated with the River Road Collector Wells that will expire on June 4, 2008 Applicant/agent White Rock Holdings Assoc., LLC/City of Middletown Water/Sewer Dept.
3. Approved application for a three year "General Permit" for proposed activity which includes minor maintenance work that the P/W Dept. performs (existing drainage pipes, inlets/outlets, brush/sediment removal & general roadway repairs. Applicant/agent City of Middletown Public Works Dept. (08-06)
4. Approved application to improve facility at Millbrook Pumping Station by replacing ageing/broken equipment with new reliable equipment to reduce sewage releases and flooding of pump station components. Applicant/Agent City of Middletown Water/Sewer Dept. (08-07)
5. Determined that an application submitted for Agency Review for stockpiling of river dredge spoils within 100' upland review area to be located at 1866 River Road does not need a permit. Applicant/agent David Carpenter, Middletown Power LLC. (08-05)
